- Must be JIB Gold card – approved electrician
- Have at least 10 years' experience in the industry
- Must possess particular practical, productive and electrical engineering skills with adequate technical supervisory knowledge so as to be able to work on their own proficiently and carry out electrical installation work without immediate supervision in the most efficient and economical manner
- Be able to set out jobs from drawings and specifications and requisition the necessary installation materials
- Be able to accept responsibility for the proper completion of jobs and, if required, supervise other operatives.
- Have a thorough working knowledge of the National Working Rules for the Electrical Contracting Industry, of the current IEE Regulations for Electrical Installations, of the Electricity Supply Regulations, 1988, issued by the Electricity Commissioners so far as they deal with Consumers' Installations (ie Regulations 22-29 inclusive and 31), of any Regulations dealing with Consumers' Installations which may be issued, relevant British Standards and Codes of Practice, and of the Construction Industry Safety Regulations.
